March 3rd to 9th (Unreached People Groups)

- 1. Pray for Mayotte, Unreached people group. Mayotte, 99% of which are Muslims; other religions, 1%. Pray for a spiritual breakthrough among these people.
- 2. Cast out the spirit of Islam and traditional religions that are holding these people captive. Ask God to break down every barrier to the prosperity of the gospel among these people.
- 3. Pray that the mind of these people will be opened to receive the gospel.
- 4. Pray for Dukawa, the unreached people group. The Dukawa are located in the Yauri division of Sokoto Province. The Christians among

- them are 6.50%, Evangelical Christians are 0.51%. Pray for the salvation of the Dukawas.
- 5. Ask God to break down every barrier to the prosperity of the gospel among the Dukawas. Ask God to strengthen the few Christians among them and grant them courage to witness to their friends and family members.
- 6. Pray for United Arab Emirates; United Arab Emirates: Population 6,072,475; Religion: Islam (79%), Christianity (9%), Others (15%). Ask God to break down the stronghold of Islam among these people.
- 7. Pray for the nullification of laws banning the preaching of the gospel. Pray for wisdom for Christians seeking to discreetly share the gospel with the people in this Emirate.

March 10th to 16th (The Mission Work of TGTBC Ogbomoso)

- 1. Pray for every member of the Outreach ministry that God will grant us wisdom, grace, and strength to be able to carry out our God-given assignment this year as God intended.

- 2. Pray for their salvation. Pray that God will deliver them from spiritual blindness and help them to see Jesus as the only Way to God.

- 3. Pray that they will begin to see foolishness of trusting in and depending on charms. Pray that Jesus will reveal Himself to the Fulanis as He did to Paul.
- 4. Pray for the missionaries that are working among them that God will grant them more grace, patience and courage.
- 5. Pray that God will stir up the church to take up the responsibility of reaching the Fulanis with the gospel.
- 6. Pray for the Hausas that God will break the grip of Islam upon them. Pray that God will open the eyes of as many of them who have heard the gospel to see Jesus and take decisions for Him.
- 7. Pray for boldness, dedication and faithfulness for the Hausa Christians to declare their faith in the Lord publicly anywhere any time.

March 31st to April 6th (The Church Pastor)

- 1. Pray for our pastor, Rev Segun Babalola that God will continue to give him wisdom, discernment and direction as he provides leadership for the church.
- 2. Pray that the hand of Lord will continually be upon him and give him victory over every attack of men and of the devil.

- 3. Pray for Tunisia. Tunisia's is Population 11,403,800. Religion: Muslim 99.1%, other 1%. Pray to the Lord of the harvest to raise workers to reach the millions of the un-evangelized in Tunisia.
- 4. Pray for the believers in Christ to have endurance as they live by faith. Pray for the government to officially recognize the Tunisian church.
- 5. Pray for Western South Asian Muslims that God will open their hearts to the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- 6. Pray for the gospel of peace to permeate every region, communities and homes of Muslims within South Asian.
- 7. Pray for courage to follow Christ for South Asian Christians facing persecution.

- 4. Pray against the spirit of idolatry which makes it difficult for them to surrender their lives to Christ. Pray and ask God to open their eyes to see Jesus as the only way to God.
- 5. Pray for Dukawas of Niger and Kebbi States, ask God to break down every stronghold and the barriers that prevent them from believing in Jesus Christ.
- 6. Pray against the spread of Islam among the Dukawas and in these States. Pray that God will stop it. Pray for them that their hearts will open to the gospel and they will accept it.
